James Ayers '83 is recognized for his work in oils. He also creates artwork in pastels and bronze sculptures.

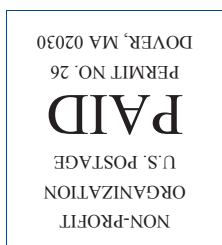
Walter Horak, current CRS art teacher, is a professional sculptor working in wood and bronze.
