SUMMIT CLASSROOM PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Refund Policy: Students who register for the class but withdraw prior to the start of the first session will receive a full refund of the program price. Students who withdraw after the first session but prior to the start of the second session will receive a refund of the program price, minus \$100. Students who withdraw after the second session but prior to the start of the third session will receive a refund of the program price, minus \$150. No refund will be granted once the third session begins. Please note that you must contact the Summit office directly to withdraw from the program. Refunds will be based on the date of the call and not on the number of sessions the student has actually attended.

Behavior Policy: All students enrolled in a Summit course must maintain appropriate behavior at all times. Students must adhere to all school rules and regulations, respect their classmates and teachers, and contribute to a positive learning environment. Summit will not provide refunds to students expelled for behavioral reasons.

Extended Time: Extended time accommodations will not be offered during the scheduled practice test. If you are approved for extended time and would like to use your accommodations, we would be happy to discuss alternative arrangements. Attendance/Make-Up Sessions: The schedule of classes has been pre-arranged with the host location. Students are required to attend each session. If a student must miss a practice test session, we will mail the test home for the student to complete. For more information on making up missed content, log in to our online portal following the missed class to read instructors' notes, or speak with the class instructor(s) directly. Summit will not offer makeup classes for missed lessons.

Class Cancellations: If classes are cancelled at the school, our classes will also be cancelled. School cancellations will be announced by the school. Summit will email parents and students of a class cancellation as soon as we have that information. The class will be made up at the next available opportunity.

Materials: Students are responsible for bringing supplies for personal use, such as pencils and calculators. Summit will provide all other course materials. Course materials will be distributed to students during the first instructional session of the class.

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Students who receive need-based financial assistance from their school are eligible to receive similar aid for the Summit course. Summit matches the percentage of need-based financial aid offered by the school and applies it to the total cost of the course, however, *all students are subject to a \$250 non-refundable course fee*.

Please note that only the student's financial aid from the school, and no other sources, will be considered when calculating matching aid. Upon registration, students are required to pay the non-refundable course fee of \$250. Once we receive confirmation of financial assistance from your school, we will calculate a final course fee and bill you for any balance due.

Example calculations:

- Student A receives financial aid and registers for a \$700 course using the financial aid coupon code during checkout, which prompts a payment of the \$250 non-refundable course fee. Summit then contacts the school to verify the percentage of need-based financial aid that is awarded towards tuition. The school discloses that the student receives 30% aid, so the student's final cost of the Summit course is 70% of the \$700, or \$490. Student A has already paid the \$250 non-refundable course fee so the additional balance due is \$240 ($\$490 - \$250 = \240 due).
- Student B receives a different level of financial aid from the school. During registration for the \$700 course, the student uses the financial aid coupon code during checkout, which prompts a payment of the \$250 non-refundable course fee. Summit then contacts Student B's school to verify the percentage of need-based financial aid that's awarded towards tuition. The school informs Summit that Student B receives 100% aid from the school, so the cost of the course for the student is the \$250 non-refundable course fee that has already been paid upon registration.
